One-Year Student Improvement Goals

ELA: The current eleventh grade students will meet or exceed last year's eleventh grade state average of 74% proficient. Last year as tenth graders 67% of those students were proficient. This is an increase of approximately two more students reaching proficiency.

MATH: The current fifth grade students will meet or exceed last year's fifth grade state average of 63% proficient. Last year as fourth graders 45% of those students were proficient. This is an increase of approximately seven more students reaching proficiency.

SCIENCE: The current 8th grade students will meet or exceed last year's state average of 65% proficient. Last year 61% of 8th graders were proficient. (*note different students)
